Special Report: Compliance with Citizen-Centric Reporting Requirements

Report No. 20-04 Date: March 13, 2020

The Office of the Public Auditor (OPA) presents this special report on government agencies' compliance with Public Law 20-83 on the submission of a Citizen-Centric Report (CCR) 30 days after fiscal-year (FY) end. This law was signed into law on November 19, 2018 and is codified in 1 CMC §2311.

In August 2019, OPA invited government agencies to attend a three-hour training session conducted by the Graduate School USA and funded by the Department of Interior, Office of Insular Affairs. The training's goal was to go over the report's purpose and discuss general content. Our records showed an estimated attendance of 110 participants from 70 government agencies.

Submissions

As of January 24, 2020, OPA received 67 CCRs from various government agencies, 47 of which were submitted after the initial deadline. From those 47 agencies that submitted late, 11 agencies are subject to penalty. See Appendix 1 for more details. OPA was not able to determine the total number of agencies that failed to submit a CCR as a certified list was neither stated in the law nor made available to OPA. CCRs are required to be posted on the agency's website and on the websites of the Office of the Governor, the CNMI Legislature, and OPA. All CCRs submitted are readily accessible on OPA's website. Clarification Needed in the Law

OPA will communicate with the Legislature regarding areas in the law that need clarification. For example, some agencies submitted their reports collectively, inclusive of all divisions, while other agencies submitted separate reports for each division. In another example, some agencies questioned if the law applied to them because (1) the agency did not receive an appropriation by the Legislature; (2) the agency was inactive; and/or (3) the board has yet to meet a quorum.


Agency Concerns

OPA has received concerns from reporting agencies regarding the time allotted to gather and summarize performance and financial data. Some agencies were limited to submitting reports based on FY 2018 data because they were not comfortable with reporting unaudited figures, whereas other agencies were able to submit reports with FY 2019 data after the October 30, 2019 deadline. In addition, some have raised concerns that the agency does not have a website to publish their reports. Furthermore, agencies were concerned with whether they should still be required to file an annual report as required by other statutes due to efficiency purposes.

A four-page report that was designed by the Association of Government Accountants to simplify communication with citizens using a format that is simple and easy to understand.

When is the Report Due?

Each year on October 30 or

November 29, before penalty*

*First-offense: \$50 per day; Second Offense: \$100 per day
