HIGHLIGHTS

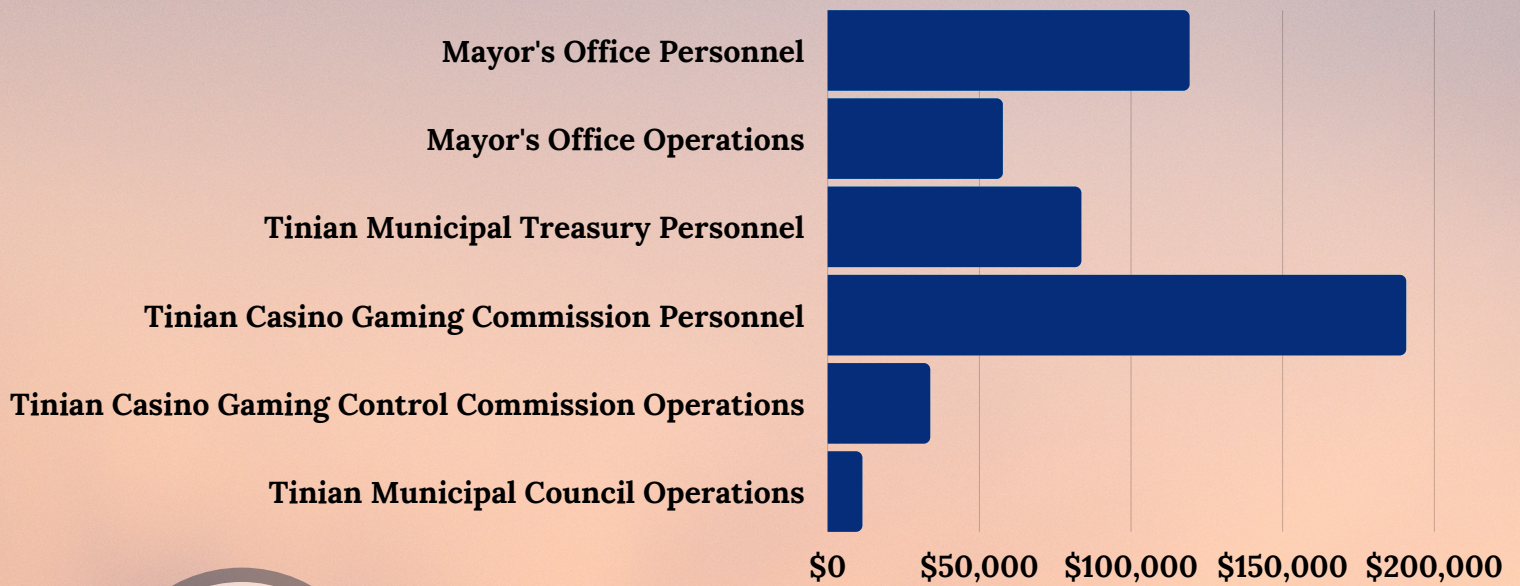
- ➔ Near completion of the Marpo Heights II road paving phase I.

- ➔ Completed architectural design of the proposed Tinian Civic Center.
- ➔ The Naval Mobile Construction Battalion 4 (Seabees) completed phase one (1) of the Tinian Harbor repair project.
- ➔ Unveiling of the first-ever Tinian Pride Heart Monument.
- ➔ A successful turnout of Tinian's first-ever Beef, Beer & Bands (BBB) Festival.

- ➔ Near completion of all village signs and statues.



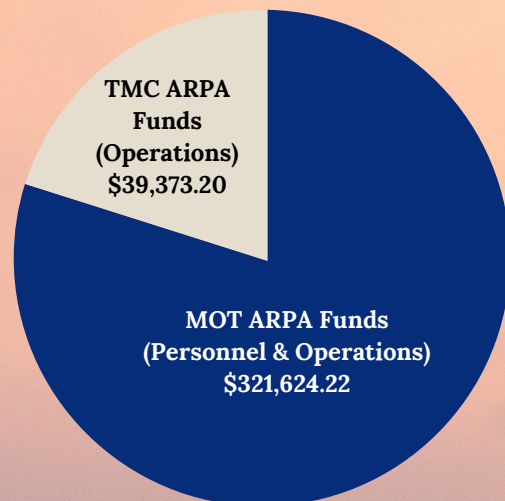
