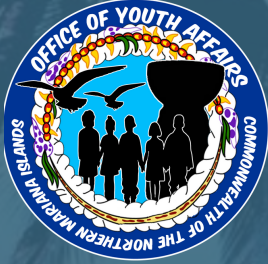

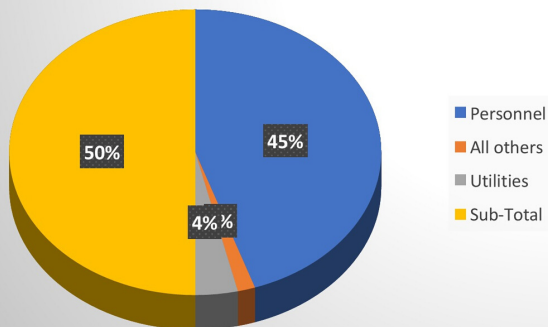

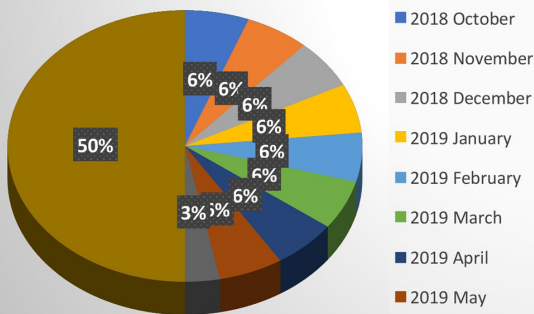
## YOUTH AFFAIRS -1020 Schedule of Monthly Allotments -Actual FY 2019 (October to June) and Projected Allotments (July to September)

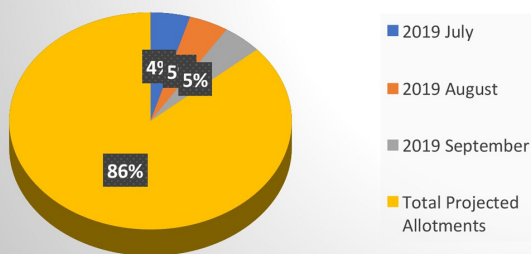
